



Worm Tea Brewing Guide

A simple, high-performance method for healthier plants.

1. Fill Water

Fill a 5-gallon bucket with water.

2. Remove Chlorine

Let it sit 24 hours to dissipate chlorine.

3. Add Castings

Place worm castings in a mesh bag or strainer and submerge.

4. Aerate

Insert an aquarium air stone and turn on the pump for constant bubbling.

5. Feed Microbes

Add a small amount of unsulfured molasses.

6. Brew

Let it brew for at least 24 hours with continuous aeration.

7. Use Fresh

Use within 24 hours of brewing for maximum effectiveness.

Result

A living, oxygen-rich solution that improves nutrient uptake, root strength, and plant performance.
